We would like to explain our behaviour and rewards systems that will be introduced to your child over the next few weeks.

Group Rewards

During group time or continuous provision the children are given shiny green treasure to put into their group pot when they have been following the class rules or achievements that they have made. Children will be given treasure for following the 'Good to be Green' rules or special achievements that they have made.

1. We work hard.
2. We listen.
3. We are honest.
4. We look after property.
5. We are kind and gentle.
6. We are helpful.

The group that wins the most treasure at the end of the week will win the 'Good to Be Green Frog'. This will stay with their key worker group for the following week. The group that win will also have a treat from the golden box.

Good to be Green Frog

Behaviour System

All children have a frog that sits on a log. This indicates that children are following the school's 'Good to be Green' rules.

If a child breaks a golden rule they will be given a choice to stop any inappropriate behaviour. If they continue to carry on with this behaviour their frog will be moved onto the yellow thinking log. This will give the child the opportunity to think about their behaviour. This will mean that they will miss some of their Golden Time.

If the child continues not to follow the Good to be Green system, they will go onto the red log. This will mean they will miss all of their Golden Time on a Friday afternoon. They will also miss the end of term treat.

If your child goes onto any of the yellow or red logs their behaviour will be recorded.

Parents will be contacted if their child goes onto the red log.

The green, yellow and red cards will prepare your child for the behaviour systems that are in place in the Reception classroom.

Golden Time

Every Friday afternoon from 2.00 - 2.55pm the children will choose an activity or treat for good behaviour e.g. A visit to Bob's garden, decorating cakes, popcorn and a movie, etc.

End of Term

The children are invited to spend an hour on a very special treat. In the past this has included the 'Space Bus,' archery or a giant inflatable slide.
